## III. Conduct an overview of the new STAR/API/AYP Data

We have the following data available:

- Whole school and individual grade level results for English Language Arts
- Whole school and individual grade level results for Math
- Socioeconomically Disadvantaged Students results for English Language Arts and Math
- English Language Learners results for English Language Arts and Math
- Special Education Students for English Language Arts and Math
- Ethnic groups for English Language Arts and Math

Our goal is to review the first two reports (whole school by grade level for Math and ELA.) Within the next few weeks, the AMS staff members will conduct an interpretation of the results and those interpretations will be presented at a future SSC meeting.

## IV. API, AYP, & Program Improvement Year One process.

At the time this agenda was drafted (09-18-2012), there are no Federal or State reports yet available. Therefore, we do not know our current status with regards to Federal Program Improvement or CA State Academic Performance Index.
